

Church Building Team Update

- •The Refurbished Bells are scheduled to be returned to St Mary's from Ohio by parishioners. They are scheduled to be installed by the end of August.
- •The Illuminated Cross is scheduled to be installed on top of the Bell Tower this week.
- The Curbing and Concrete Work are scheduled to be completed soon.
- •The Parking Lot will be paved in September.
- •The Corpus has been completed and has been delivered from Germany.
- •The Cross for our Crucifix, which has been constructed by parishioners from beams of our Fire-Damaged Former Church Structure, has been completed.
- •The Presider Chairs have been completed.
- •The Four Altar Candle Stands have been completed.
- •The Stone Medallion over the front door, for which we have been patiently waiting, is scheduled to be on site by the end of August. Once installed, the brick front can be completed along with the front entrance system and the front exterior concrete.
- •The Interior Sheetrock and finishing is being worked on now.
- •The Stations of the Cross, which have been refurbished by a parishioner, are being prepared for installation soon.
- •The Large Wooden Arches in the clerestory are being unwrapped from their protective coverings and are being finished as the painting in this area is completed
- •The Cabinets have been installed in the Administration Space.



Face Coverings With regard to public liturgies, the Governor's



executive order **requires** that people coming to Mass wear a face covering upon entering the church, during Mass, and when exiting the building. The order grants some exemptions from the mandate, including children ages 5 and under and people who are unable to wear or tolerate a face

covering due to medical or mental health conditions or other reasons (Minnesota Department of Health Stay Safe MN Guidance for Gatherings: Faith-based Communities, Places of Worship, and Ceremonies July 28, 2020).


ProLife Billboards As many of you may know, there will be no Stearns County Fair this year, so with that being said, we will not be




