





On Liturgy – Signs and Symbols --Chris Calderone

Last week we explored some seasonal church symbols that might resonate well with one group of people but perhaps not another. We also recalled how most everyone understands the intent and meaning of a stop sign. Are there "stop signs" in churches; signs and symbols that everyone understands and resonates with? When entering a church for the first time, we may very well stop at one such symbol: the cross.

The cross might be the most universally recognized symbol of the Church, yet it is found in near-infinite shapes, sizes, and styles. The altar is another immediately recognizable symbol. Altars, however, are designed in almost as many ways as there are churches. The Church directs that altars should be made of worthy, solid, and properly constructed material. A "worthy material" might be a variety of natural stone for one community, or wood for another community. The Church also directs that sacred vessels be made of worthy material, but recognizes that materials considered worthy for patens and chalices will differ from region to region around the world. Diversity is encouraged!

Most people would find a cardboard box to be absolutely unworthy of serving as a tabernacle. It begs the question, though: what does make a tabernacle "worthy"? Is it gold? Is it large? Is it accessible? Or is it more of the environment that surrounds the tabernacle? What is worthy?

What signs and symbols point you towards God, who first comes to us not as a mighty king but as an infant lying in a lowly manger? Can God be found even in a straw of hay? As Christmas dawns this week, let us consider how we find God's extraordinary grace even in the ordinary.




