Church of St. Mary Parish Council Message...

Church Building Team Update.

- Inside of the Worship Space: Work continues as the "cloud-like ceiling wings" are being framed and the ceiling is being insulated. Design continues on the sacred oils and book shrine cabinetry, interior granite and dedication crosses.
- Inside of the Administration Space: Work on the soffits, fire suppression system, electrical system, insulation and drywall continues.
- Outside of the structure: Work continues on the bricklaying and installation of the stucco-like exterior material which will cover the non-brick and stone outside areas of the church. Shingling will be completed once the installation of the stucco-like material work is finished. Above is a picture of the west side of the worship space, north of the administration space.
- The construction calendar is on schedule and we are looking for completion in possibly late fall or early winter of 2020. After construction completion, there will still be much work to be finished with installation of sacred items, furniture, pews, etc.
