

On Liturgy – Mission, Part 2

Last week I mentioned that a small group of parishioners is currently examining our Parish Mission Statement. This is a healthy process for any parish, and while it is not related to or a result of our new church project, it can tell us a great deal about ourselves, our parish life, and ways that our new church can support that parish life. Here's how:

I invite you to ask yourself and each other these questions: Who are we? What do we as a faith community believe in? What is our parish mission? Some answers are obvious: as Christians, Christ himself has given us our mission: "Love God and love one another as I have loved you," or perhaps more sacramentally, "Do this in memory of me." However, each faith community is unique, just as each of us is a unique member of the one Body of Christ. We, the Church of Saint Mary, have our own identity and our own mission as a community of believers. We will each have our own unique answers to the above questions. When we identify the common answers between us, we find our community's mission. As discussed last week, this mission can and often does inform how we worship together. Like cherished family traditions, our parish holds onto liturgical symbols and traditions that speak to our unique identity. Our mission can even dictate what design aspects of our new church are more important than others. Our Parish Mission Statement is a powerful force!
