



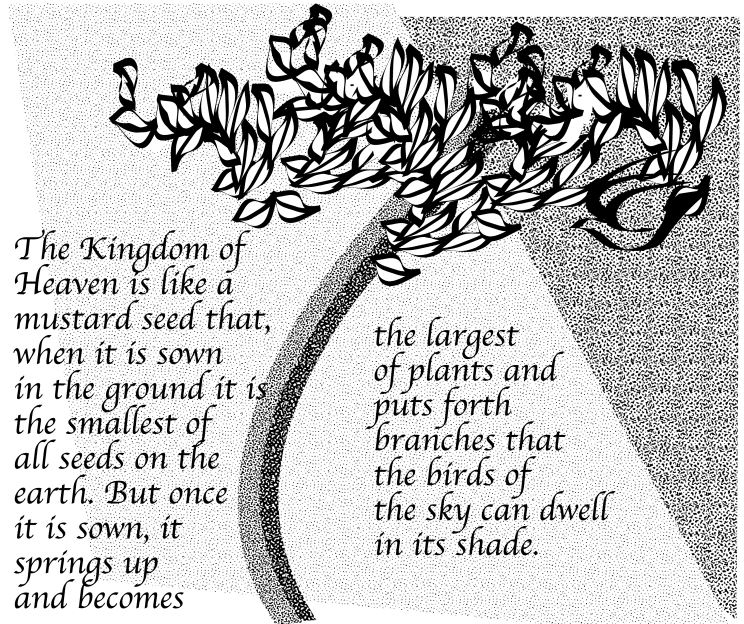

**Parish Council message**

● On 6/12/18 a delegation from St Mary's presented the proposal for a new worship space and facilities to the Diocesan Building Commission (DBC). This delegation included Fr. Marv (Pastor), Jody Wehlage and Ray Primus (Trustees), Kurt Schwieters (Parish Council), Harvey Keller (Finance Council), Troy Tomford (St. Mary's School Board), Ken Griesemer (Liturgical Design Consultant) and Mike Juhl (Architect). This presentation included discussion of our parish journey and school lunch issues, description of the new site, architectural drawings, liturgical reasoning and financing. The presentation went very well! The DBC was grateful for our efforts and gave us much positive feedback. They are taking our proposal under consideration and will soon make a decision with recommendations. The DBC informed us that we should hear from them within the next month.

**On Liturgy – Matrimony** --Chris Calderone

The sacrament of Matrimony has its foundations in creation, unity, and fruitfulness – themes which are heard in the sturdy growth of trees and fruitful blessings God bestows on us in today's Scripture. The Church desires to celebrate this sacrament in churches, but churches are not always hospitable locations for weddings. How can we welcome and encourage couples to celebrate Matrimony in our new church?

The sacramental moment of Matrimony is performed by the couple in the Exchange of Vows, before God and the gathered assembly. Vows should be exchanged in a dignified place in the church, seen and heard by the entire assembly. Here's where the "ritual space" comes into play once again – the same place where so many other sacramental moments will be celebrated. Other design elements include a generous place for the bride and groom to sit within the sanctuary, accessibility to a Marian statue for couples who wish to make a devotion during the wedding, and proper seating for wedding parties and family members.

Hospitality may also be found outside the worship space. A spacious gathering space, preparation rooms for both the bride and groom, and vibrant outdoor gardening and landscaping will make our church an inviting place for weddings. "Wedding season" in a church should not feel burdensome - to the couples or to the parish! Instead, let's imagine a new church that celebrates and lifts up the sacred unity of Matrimony!
