Parish Council Message...

Church Building Team Update:


- The Parish Council, Finance Council and Construction Committee Chairs met last week to review, discuss and take action on construction-related items requiring decisions by mid-July. These included the interior beams, the interior glass-paneled wall separating the worship space from the gathering space, and the **stone** designated for the baptismal font and also desired for the interior wainscoting. Decisions were also made regarding the placement of driveways and utilities. A final decision regarding the exterior **brick** will be made by the middle of the month.
- In a previous message, we referred to the incorporation of "Value Engineering" into the construction project for our new church. This long established (since the 1940's) and logical approach is a key component in any major construction project. It is being incorporated into our project to insure that the parish "gets the best structure for the money available." In our project, Value Engineering requires that the architect, general contractor, sub-contractors and parish leadership including the finance council, design committee, construction committee, Pastor, liturgical design consultant and parish volunteers work together in a systematic, collaborative and organized approach to construct the parish's new worship space facilities including the gathering space and the administration area at the lowest cost. This is achieved through the use and substitution of alternative materials and methods with less cost – without sacrificing functionality, beauty or quality.
- This important work associated with constructing our new worship space is moving forward in an efficient and productive manner with excellent results due to ongoing communication and interaction among parishioners, parish leadership, our architect and contractors.


