

### On Liturgy – Source and Summit --Chris Calderone

As our parish celebrates Mass for the first time on the site of our new church, I want to highlight one particular detail of this liturgy. As preparations for this Mass came together, we marked two key locations on site: the projected locations of both the new church's baptismal font and altar. The large wood cross, which will mark the land as holy through the coming months, was placed at the location of the baptismal font – both are foundations of our Christian faith. The wood cross will soon be relocated to the projected location of the new church's altar. During the Mass, this spot was marked with a different symbol: the "gifts" table, which held the bread and wine for offering. Why?

The Church recognizes the Eucharist as the "source and summit of the Christian life". This takes on new meaning here: bread and wine are the sources, the substances that are brought forth to the altar to become the true presence of Christ in his Body and Blood. Likewise, this weekend we celebrate the land – the site of the new church; the "source" from which so much will be created – by celebrating the Eucharist there. One day, bread and wine will return to that same spot to become the Body and Blood of Christ, at the new altar of our new church, the "summit" of all our parish's efforts over the course of this project. There and then, we will again celebrate the Eucharist, the source and summit of our Christian life, and we will do so for generations to come.
