Parish Council message...

- The Parish Council is grateful to each of the parish households and school families who participated in the feasibility study regarding parish needs, priorities and fundraising possibilities. This information will be extremely important for our parish's future.
- The Parish Council, Church Building Team, and Finance Council appreciate all of the feedback and input received regarding the future of our parish since our 2/11/18 presentation to the parish. This feedback continues to be gathered through feedback forms, committee meetings, parish workshops with Ken Griesemer (Liturgical Design Consultant), and many individual conversations with parishioners. This information has been given to Ken G. and the parish's architect (HMA) resulting in continued changes and improvements being made to the design of our worship space and related structures.
- Parish leadership will present its proposal for a new worship space and facilities to the Diocesan Building Commission in June 2018.
- The Parish Council and St. Mary's School Board continue to work on options for the lunch program at St. Marys School.



Mark's narrative of the Ascension of Jesus is short, as is his Gospel. No sooner was Jesus taken up to heaven than did the disciples turn around and go forth to preach and minister in the name of the Lord. The Feast of the Ascension also celebrates the sending forth of disciples to all places and for all time to proclaim the Gospel, in word and in deed. We continue this mission today.

The continued grace, presence, and effective action of God here on earth is perhaps most recognized in the Sacraments. While the number and significance of Sacraments have changed throughout Church history, today we celebrate seven Sacraments, instituted by Christ and entrusted to the Church. By celebrating these Sacraments, we, the disciples of Christ, continue God's work on earth through initiation, healing, and service to communion.

One of the primary missions of our new church and facilities must be to support and encourage the celebration of these Sacraments.
