A message from the parish council...

On May 2, 2017, Fr. Marv, members of our Parish Council (PC), parishioners and others committed to "Restore the Structure of the Church of St. Mary," met to learn more about the letters from the Diocesan Building Commission (DBC) and Bishop Kettler. We are very grateful for the opportunity to have candid and sincere conversation about our concerns, our process and our direction.

The meaning of their message is (taken directly from DBC letter):

"It is the Commission's recommendation to deny approval for the proposed Pure Restoration Project. In consideration of the previous outlined thoughts and comments, the commission further recommends that building a new facility that completely addresses a 21st century parish and its future needs is the direction the Parish needs to pursue."

What did we learn?

The Bishop will stand by the above statement. It was repeated many times during our discussion.

The 4 walls cannot be used "as is."

A new facility will be used for worship space. This may be able to incorporate as much of our church as possible. (statues, altar, stations, windows, blue arched ceilings, architecture style etc... as possibilities)

There may be some ability to use some of current structure. (possibly entrance, steeples, windows, some of walls, etc). Much work will be necessary to evaluate this.

The Bishop will have the final decision and he will use DBC to review and make recommendations regarding any new proposal.

Where do we go from here?

Hire a Liturgical Design Consultant (LDC) as soon as possible.

Work with architects, builders, parishioners and LDC to identify if any part of structure can be and should be used (entrance, narthex, steeples, standing walls, etc) as we plan a facility together. (What could be old? What must be new?)

Examine if the next proposal can be accepted by the DBC and the Bishop. The rubric has specific criteria that must be met. It also must be financially prudent.

Work together.






