Parish Council message...

- During the past few months The WellSpring Group performed a Feasibility Study for St Mary's Parish to determine fundraising options, understand parishioner perceptions of the development plans and determine if fundraising efforts should be combined with proposed work on St. Mary's School.
- This information was obtained through personal interviews and an online and paper survey. All parishioners and parents of St. Mary's School children were encouraged to complete this survey.
- The Parish Council and Finance Council would like to share the following key information from this Feasibility Study:
 - -There is very good support for the Church of St. Mary and its Facilities.
 - The Church of St. Mary:
 - Should not delay in building the Worship Space.
 - Should investigate fundraising activities in the future.
 - Should continue to support St. Mary's School in exploring options for the lunch program.
- In June 2018, this information will be brought forward to the Diocesan Building Commission along with the proposal for construction and the master plan.
- The Parish Council, Church Building Team and Finance Council are very grateful for all of the work by volunteers and St. Mary's School Board as this information is being prepared for this presentation.



On Liturgy – Baptism -- Chris Calderone

On Trinity Sunday, we hear these words of Jesus in Matthew's Gospel: "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." In its most basic and raw form, the sacrament of Baptism requires only water and those same spoken words; "I baptize you in the name of..." invoking our Triune God and the God of our Christian faith. Celebrating the sacrament of Baptism as a community of faith relies on a church that speaks of our common baptism and welcomes the newly-baptized into our community.

The primary symbol of Baptism is, of course, water – which gives the baptismal font near-equal importance. Newer churches often respond to this by giving the baptismal font a place of prominence near the entrance of the church. The same community thought and input that will go into our new church's altar and ambo should go into the baptismal font. Remember, too, the holy oils used for Baptism, and the location of the ambry discussed last week.

Outside the worship space, an attached gathering space is a vital place for families celebrating baptisms to gather together before and after. It is worth noting that all sacraments are celebrations – including Holy Communion at every Mass! A gathering space will welcome everyone into celebration before and after every sacrament.
