Parish Council Message...

We hope that you continue to be as excited by the great news we shared last weekend as we are!

First, after all of the work and dedication of our parish volunteers, committees and leadership along with our architect and liturgical design consultant, our prayers were finally answered earlier this month when **Fr. Marv received Bishop Kettler's letter "enthusiastically" approving our new church building project and allowing our moving forward with the "beautifully designed structure."** Bishop Kettler's letter to Fr Marv is posted on our parish website.

Second, a year ago in a presentation welcomed by the public, we presented the initial preliminary design for our new worship space and related facilities on our new site south of the cemetery on Kraft Drive SE. Parish leadership along with the Church Building Team (CBT), volunteers and committees, and its architect and liturgical design consultant have sought much input from the parish at large and incorporated much of that input, where possible, into the new facilities. **Beginning this weekend (3/23-24) after each Mass, various display boards will be available for parishioner viewing with CBT and council members standing by to explain the content of the boards and address questions regarding the final church designs.** These display boards will show various interior and exterior views of the worship space, gathering space/narthex and small Administration Center. Please contact parish leadership or the Church Building Team if you have any questions. This information will also be on our parish website, www.oneinfaith.org.

Finally, to help address the construction cost of our new facilities we are announcing that this weekend is the **kick off of the Church of St Mary Forward in Faith Capital Campaign to raise \$2,400,000.** This week's Sunday Bulletin contains a Campaign Newsletter with additional information about our campaign to help build our church. Next week more capital campaign related information will be sent to each parish household.
