

On Liturgy – Easter Vigil

On Saturday, March 31st, at 8:30pm, the somber silence lingering since Good Friday will be broken. It will start with a single flame, the Paschal Candle, and the Light of Christ will spread throughout the assembly to illuminate the entire church. We'll sing "Gloria!" and "Alleluia!" to herald the resurrection of Jesus Christ. The Easter Vigil is a "Ritual of Entry". Around the world, people enter churches with candles to banish the darkness. Catechumens enter the Baptismal Font, and candidates enter into full communion with the Catholic Church through Confirmation and Eucharist. Finally, like Jesus emerging from the tomb, we joyously emerge from the church and enter the Easter Season.

This past week, our liturgical consultant Ken Griesemer gave two of four parish presentations on liturgy as it pertains to our new church designs. One of the main focus areas was on "approach and entry" of the church. From the parking lot – even from I-94, how might people experience God's presence as they approach and enter this church, on the Easter Vigil and throughout the year? How will this church show the Light of Christ to all who see it and enter its doors? More importantly, how will we, the Body of Christ, show that Light to all who we encounter? Every time we enter the church, we will also emerge from it, going forth as Bearers of Christ and light to the darkness. Easter is coming soon!
