One in Faith (4) Administrative Coordinator for Faith Formation The One in Faith 4 cluster of parishes (St. Andrew's, St. John's, St. Michael's, and St. Mary's) is seeking a person to coordinate the administrative responsibilities for their joint faith formation program. This position averages 10 hours per week, but the amount of time per week will vary, depending on the time of year. Although significant computer work is required, the faith formation administrative coordinator is also responsible for initiating and maintaining good communication with our faith formation families.
