
Church of St. Mary Parish Council Message...

DEMOLITION OF THE FIRE-DAMAGED CHURCH STRUCTURE

- As has been previously discussed with the City of Melrose, the Parish Council, working with its various committees, has undertaken and completed the necessary pre-demolition steps in preparation for the upcoming demolition of the fire-damaged church building.
- The work already undertaken by the Parish Council in preparation for demolition included having the required Environmental Assessment Worksheet (EAW) prepared at the Church's expense and submitted to the City of Melrose, reviewed by the City and its consultants, and finally accepted by the City in December 2019.
- Since the EAW acceptance by the City, the following necessary Pre-Demolition Services/Activities were completed which included hiring Enviro-Safe, Inc as project manager, removal of asbestos and hazardous materials (Haz Mat), removal of the bells, remaining windows, radiators, etc, decommissioning of the elevator and removal of various exterior onsite items such as electrical transformers.
- The demolition company is scheduled to be onsite Monday May 18, 2020 to begin the final demolition phase.
- Throughout this process, the Parish Council has considered having a service of closure. The ever-changing mitigation and social distancing requirements of this pandemic have made this more difficult as we await diocesan guidance regarding such a service. We are continuing to evaluate possibilities for this process as our uncertain environment continues.

CORONAVIRUS / COVID-19

- As the Coronavirus and Covid-19 have affected the Melrose community, we are working closely with our contractors and consultants to follow an excellent readiness plan with proper protocols.
- Our contractors and construction workers are working within the recommendations of the CDC and the MDH to minimize the possibility of disease and transmission of the virus.
- As we expected to have community members and workers becoming ill with the virus, work on our site will continue to have safety and public health as our number one priority.
- This may mean that construction progress may slow or even be delayed depending upon testing results and site preparation/ construction isolation recommendations.


